Setting the Stage – Dickinson travels to Lancaster for a rare Centennial Conference night game. The Red Devils take a 2-0 record into its CC opener on Friday night. They face-off against Franklin & Marshall, playing for possession of the Conestoga Wagon. The Red Devils are coming off a thrilling overtime win over Hobart College while the Diplomats suffered a 20-0 loss on the road at Washington & Lee last weekend.

Last Week - Dickinson came off the ropes to deliver a stunning blow to visiting Hobart in the Devils' home opener last Saturday. Trailing 24-19, Michael Dalton forced a fumble into the hands of senior Will Scott who went 86 yards for a touchdown with just 47 seconds remaining in the game. Sophomore QB Ian Mitchell dove in for the two-point conversion, turning the tables on the Statesmen, taking a 27-24 lead.

Hobart had a little fight left, converting a 36-yard field-goal as time expired to send the game into overtime. The Statesmen won the toss and elected to start on offense. The Devil defense held, forcing a 42-yard field-goal attempt which sailed wide left.

Dickinson moved the ball to the 20 and junior kicker Matt Stark split the uprights from 37 yards to give the Devils a 30-27 victory.

The Diplomats traveled to Washington & Lee for its season opener last weekend. The Generals held F&M to just 122 yards of offense. Zach Romash led the way defensively with 11 tackles while Jeff Kellar had a pair of interceptions.

Lat Year- Dickinson scored three touchdowns in the second quarter en route to a 28-14 victory in Carlisle. Ryne Cantwell caught a pair of TD passes out of the backfield while WR Chris McNerney scored once by air and once on the ground.

Mike D'Amico reached the century mark for the second straight week, rushing for a career-high 161 yards on 21 carries. Matt Torchia completed 19-of-30 passes for 214 yards.

Eric Dube matched a game-high with 10 tackles (8 solo). Matt Williams tallied seven tackles, two sacks and a forced fumble. Victor Johnson added two sacks while Ryan Heinig chipped in with an interception and a fumble recovery. The Devils held F&M to just 35 yards rushing.

Diplomat QB Kyle Turner had a big afternoon, completing 25-of-51 passes for 300 yards and two touchdowns. Paul Sousa made seven catches for 116 yards.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 89-56-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game marks the 99th meeting in this storied rivalry. The Diplomats lead the series 59-36-3 but the Devils have won the last three outings. It is the Centennial Conference opener for both schools and also on the line will be the Conestoga Wagon Trophy. The Devils and Diplomats will battle for the Wagon for the 45th time, dating back to 1963. F&M holds a 25-19 edge since the institution of the trophy.

Offense - Ian Mitchell rushed for 119 yards and threw for 49 last week. He broke free for a 74 yard run in the opening quarter. First-year Tim Smith added 85 yards on 17 carries, scoring twice on the afternoon.

Tim Wells put the Devils on the board with a six-yard run after Dickinson recovered a fumble on the Hobart 13 yard line.

Defense - Senior captain Eric Dube had another strong performance, recording a game-high 18 tackles. He leads the CC with 36 tackles, averaging 18 over the first two games. He had eight solo tackles and three for losses on the day.

Dube was one of five Red Devils with double-digit tackles for the game. Will Scott finished with 13 tackles to go with his 86 yard fumble return for a touchdown. Ben Hargrave tallied 12 tackles (2-for-loss) while Mike O'Donnell and Michael Dalton each recorded 11.

Junior Tredell Johns forced the fumble that led to Dickinson's first score. He knocked the ball loose and senior Eric Hertrich recovered on the Hobart 13 yard line.

Special Teams - The Red Devil special teams were just that on Saturday. Junior kicker Matt Stark converted the game-winning field-goal from 37 yards out to give the Devils the win. He also served-up a beautiful ball on an on-side kick which was still unfortunately recovered by Hobart.

Senior punter Aren Johnson averaged 45.8 yards per kick on four punt attempts for the day. He had one inside the 20 and another that dropped inside the 10 yard line but crawled into the endzone for a touchback.

Ryan Heinig broke through to block a punt while adding seven tackles in the game.

Scouting F&M - Senior QB Kyle Turner completed only 7-of-24 passes for 59 yards last week, but had a much stronger

performance against the Devils last fall. He threw for 300 yards and two TDs in the loss in 2006.

Second-year head coach Jon Troxell will look for more offense from first-year running backs Lipton Thompson and Lorenzo Daughy-Chambers, who combined for 65 yards on the ground at Washington & Lee.

Turner will look to junior targets Paul Sousa and Mike Wood, along with sophomore George Eager and first-year Jay Ridinger in the Diplomats passing game.

Linebacker Zack Romash led F&M with 11 tackles last week while safety Jeff Kellar had a pair of interceptions.
