Setting the Stage – The Red Devils square-off against the Bullets for the 72nd time in a key Centennial Conference match-up. The Devils were idle last week, coming off their first loss of the season. They enter the game with a 5-1 overall record while Gettysburg brings in a mark of 5-2. Also on the line will be rights to the Little Brown Bucket. The Devils surrendered that trophy in 2005, but reclaimed possession last year with a 30-14 win at home.

Both teams are still very much in the hunt for the conference title, each with just one loss in CC play.

Last Week- The Red Devils were idle last week, following a 20-17 setback to Johns Hopkins the week before. The Devils battled back from a 17-7 deficit at halftime to tie the game with just under 10 minutes remaining. First-year Gordon Craig kicked a career-long 44-yard field-goal to even the score at the 9:55 mark.

Hopkins' kicker Alex Lachman answered with a 40-yard try as time expired to give the Blue Jays a 20-17 win.

Ian Mitchell rushed for 137 yards and passed for 136 to lead the Devils on offense. Eric Dube tallied a game-high 12 tackles while Ben Hargrave added 11 stops, including 1.5-for-losses. Will Scott had seven solo tackles, an interception and two pass breakups.

Gettysburg ran past Juniata 42-21 for its fifth win of the season. Tom Sturges rushed for 181 yards and two TDs to surpass the 1,000-yard mark for the third straight season. Charles Curcio racked-up 184 all-purpose yards, including a 56-yard punt return for a touchdown.

Last Year - The Red Devils regained possession of the Little Brown Bucket with a 30-14 win at Biddle last season. The Bullets snapped a nine-year losing streak in 2005, topping the Devils 17-7 in Gettysburg.

Last year's victory also secured the ninth Centennial Conference title for Dickinson. Matt Stark hit field-goals from 27, 31 and 32 yards, and converted three extra-points on the afternoon. Matt Torchia threw for 214 yards and ran for 59 yards and a touchdown. Ryne Cantwell scored twice and rushed for 75 yards on the day. Chris McInerney caught five passes for 75 yards.

On the defensive side, Eric Dube and Mike O'Donnell each recorded eight tackles while Victor Johnson made two key tackles-for-loss and added a sack. Dennis Nelson and Ryan Heinig each had touchdown-saving pass break-ups as well.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 92-57-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game marks the 72nd meeting in the series, dating back to 1892. The teams will play for the Little Brown Bucket trophy for the 39th year. The Devils lead that series 19-18-1. The teams tied 7-7 in 1995 before the Devils captured nine straight from 1996-2004.

Offense - Sophomore quarterback Ian Mitchell ranks second in the Centennial Conference in total offense, averaging 221.3 yards per game. He leads CC quarterbacks in rushing with 479 yards. He has completed just under 61 percent of his passes this season, throwing for 849 yards on 81 completions. The offensive line ranks second in the CC, allowing just 10 sacks to trail only Gettysburg, who has allowed seven. Mitchell has also only thrown one interception in 133 attempts this fall.

Mitchell is the Devils' top rusher at 79.8 yards per outing. First-year Tim Smith is second, averaging 4.5 yards per carry for just under 50 yards per game. Tim Wells and Matt Manganaro have also run well for the Devils.

Chris McInerney is second in the conference with 40 receptions on the year and in all-purpose yards, averaging 150.2 yards per game. He has 107 catches in his career, ranking second all-time at Dickinson. McInerney is the second player in school history to go over 500 yards on punt returns.

The Red Devils rank fourth in the CC in rushing and scoring offense.

Defense - Senior Eric Dube leads the conference with 83 tackles on the year. He is second all-time at Dickinson with 330 in his career. He also ranks second in career tackles-for-loss with 45, behind Keith Fischer '02 with 49.5.

Junior Ben Hargrave is third in the CC in tackles, averaging 9.8 per game. He has 59 tackles, including 4.5-for-losses.

Mike Maxwell and Will Scott each have 49 tackles on the year. Maxwell has three interceptions this season while senior Ryan Heinig leads the CC with 10 passes defended.

The Devils rank second in turnover margin at (+7) and third in rushing defense while Gettysburg owns the top spot in rushing offense.

Special Teams - First-year Gordon Craig kicked a career-long 44-yard field-goal against Johns Hopkins. He has hit 3-of-4 field-goals this season and converted 9-of-9 extra-points.

Senior punter Aren Johnson is having another solid season, averaging a career-best 37.5 yards per punt this season. He has dropped 6-of-31 inside the 20 with four touchbacks. Johnson ranks second all-time at Dickinson with 192 punts for 6,832 yards in his career.

Chris McInerney became just the third Dickinson player to accumulate 500 yards on punt returns.
