Setting the Stage – Two of the four remaining unbeaten teams in the Centennial Conference square-off in Bethlehem this weekend. The defending champions travel to conference newcomer Moravian College to face the Greyhounds for the first time in almost three decades. The teams last met in 1980 with Moravian claiming a 33-12 victory. That win tied the series 4-4-2.

The Devils look for their first win on the road against Moravian, holding an 0-3-1 record in Bethlehem.

Last Week - The Red Devils jumped out to an early lead and held off a weary but determined McDaniel 37-20. Dickinson drove 71 yards on eight plays, ending with a 17 yard scoring run by first-year Tim Smith. The Devils added three-yard touchdowns by sophomores Ian Mitchell and Tim Wells to take a 19-0 lead at the end of the first quarter.

Senior Chris McInerney returned a punt 57 yards to paydirt, then caught a pass from Mitchell for a two-point conversion to give Dickinson a 27-0 lead with 10:15 remaining in the half.

McDaniel found the endzone with 2:26 to go in the half on a one-yard run by Eric Zwilsky. The Green Terror had trouble all afternoon with errant snaps on special teams. A miscue on the extra-point forced kicker Jay Leonard to scramble, but the Devils were on top of him in a hurry to make the stop.

Trailing 27-6 at halftime, Zwilsky struck again after the break to cut the deficit to 27-13 with 9:39 remaining in the third. The teams traded possessions, giving McDaniel the ball with 47 seconds left. Senior captain Michael O'Donnell stalled the drive with his second interception of the game, scoring from 25 yards out to put the Devils in control 34-13.

Zwilsky scored his third touchdown of the game with 8:44 left on the clock to pull the Green Terror within a pair of touchdowns. Dickinson answered with a 28-yard field-goal from first-year Gordon Craig and Greg Lord tallied the Devils' third interception of the game to close the door on McDaniel.

Moravian came out on top of a shootout in Baltimore, topping Johns Hopkins 44-41. Brian Rickenbeil kicked a 34-yard, game-winning field-goal with one second remaining to keep the Greyhounds perfect on the season.

QB Marc Braxmeier tied the school record for the second time, throwing four TD passes at Hopkins. He finished with 279 yards passing, including 127 yards on five passes to Sean Hill.

Carl Robinson recorded 11 tackles and forced a fumble while Andrew Morrissey added 11 tackles as well, including one for loss, forcing a pair of fumbles to lead the Greyhounds on defense.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 91-56-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game is the 11th meeting with the series tied 4-4-2. The teams last met in 1980 with Moravian coming out on top 33-12 in Bethlehem. This is the first meeting with conference implications on the line, however, as the Greyhounds joined the CC for football this fall. Both teams are unbeaten and looking to take sole possession of the top spot in the standings.

By the Numbers - Moravian is the top scoring team in the conference while the Devils rank third. Dickinson is third in both rushing offense and rushing defense with the Greyhounds ranking 4th and 5th, respectively in those categories. The teams rank third and fourth in total defense and 1-2 in turnover margin.

Moravian holds the edge in the air, ranking third and fourth in passing offense and defense while the Devils hold the nine spot in both categories.

Offense - First-year Tim Smith reached the century mark last week, rushing for 101 yards on just nine carries, scoring a 17-yard touchdown. Sophomore fullback Tim Wells scored once as well, adding 37 yards on the ground while Matt Manganaro averaged 4.8 yards on five touches.

Chris McInerney is one of three receivers in the CC with 20 or more receptions this season. He ranks third in all-purpose yards (137.5) and returned a punt 57 yards for a touchdown against McDaniel.

Sophomore QB Ian Mitchell attempted 70 passes before throwing an interception on Saturday. He ranks sixth in the CC in rushing (75.8 yds/gm) and fifth in total offense (196.5).

Defense - Senior captain Eric Dube leads the conference with 58 tackles on the year. He led a balanced defensive attack against McDaniel, recording seven tackles on Saturday. Classmate and co-captain Michael O'Donnell had a big afternoon with a pair of interceptions, five tackles and three pass break-ups. He returned one pick 25 yards for a touchdown and earned CC Player of the Week honors for his efforts.

Junior Ben Hargrave was all over the field on Saturday, recording a game-high 14 tackles. Sophomore Micheal Maxwell added eight tackles and broke up a pair of passes. He leads the CC with three interceptions.

Special Teams - Senior punter Aren Johnson ranks second in the CC, averaging 39.9 yards per kick. He has dropped five inside the 20-yard line and is tied for the longest of the year with a 56-yarder. He pinned the Green Terror on the three-yard line with a 42-yard boot on Saturday.

McInerney ranks third in career punt return yards at Dickinson, covering 472 in his career. He ranks third in the CC for punt returns and is currently fourth for kick-off returns.

First-year Gordon Craig kicked a 28-yard field-goal on Saturday and is expected to handle kicking duties this weekend.



Mike O'Donnell earned CC Player of the Week honors. He picked-off a pair of passes last week, returning one for a TD.
