Setting the Stage – The Red Devils won their fifth straight season opener, rallying to defeat Grove City 17-13 last weekend. They will have a game under their belt as they welcome Hobart College to Biddle Field this weekend. Dickinson holds a slim 8-7-1 advantage in the series but the Statesmen have captured the last three meetings. Hobart finished 8-2 overall and 5-1 in the Liberty League last season.

Last Year - Hobart survived a shootout in Geneva last fall, scoring with just over a minute to play to pull in front of the Devils 31-28. It was a battle of gunslingers as Hobart QB Shawn Mizro completed 20-of-34 passes for 237 yards and two touchdowns. Dickinson's Matt Torchia went 21-for-31, covering 227 yards and throwing three touchdown passes. Mizro connected with Ryan LiDrazzah from 12 yards out to put Hobart on top for good with just 1:06 on the clock.

The Devil defense stalled the Hobart running game, holding the Statesmen to just 64 yards on the ground. Eric Dube posted a team-high nine tackles, including a pair for losses while Zac Reding added seven tackles and recorded three sacks.

Chris McInerney hauled in a pair of touchdown catches and finished with seven receptions for 91 yards. Ryne Cantwell rushed for 71 yards on 15 carries.

Last Week - A slow start found the Red Devils trailing host Grove City 7-3 at halftime and 13-3 late in the third quarter. Dickinson turned the tide in a matter of minutes as sophomore fullback Tim Wells scored a pair of touchdowns around a blocked punt. Wells scored on a three yard run and again just 1:18 later after Ben Hargrave blocked a punt that A.J. Reisig recovered on the Wolverines' 22 yard line. Wells reached paydirt on the very next play to put the Devils in front 17-13.

It was all defense through the fourth quarter as the Devils claimed their fifth straight season opener. The Devil defense held Grove City to just 62 yards rushing behind 18 tackles from senior Eric Dube. Dube tallied a game-high 18 tackles (8 solo), including 5.5 tackles-for-loss. Mike Maxwell added 10 tackles and Paul Titchenell recorded a pair of sacks.

Offensively, sophomore quarterback Ian Mitchell completed 17-of-25 passes for 172 yards and rushed for 31 yards. Chris McInerney caught nine passes for 102 yards on the day.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 88-56-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game marks the 17th meeting between the two teams. The Devils hold a slim 8-7-1 lead in the series but Hobart has been victorious in the last three meetings.

Offense - The Red Devils set school, single season passing records in each of the last three seasons. The graduation of two-year starter and 2006 Centennial Offensive Player of the Year Matt Torchia opened the door behind center. Sophomore Ian Mitchell earned the nod last week and turned in a solid performance in his first start at the helm. Mitchell completed 17-of-25 passes for 172 yards and rushed for another 31.

Chris McInerney had a great start to his senior season, making nine catches for 102 yards. Sophomore Pat O'Connor had five receptions for 54 yards.

Sophomore fullback Tim Wells averaged over six yards per carry, rushing for 52 yards on just eight carries, scoring twice on the afternoon.

Defense

Senior captain Eric Dube picked up right where he left off in 2006, anchoring a solid defensive effort by the Devils. Dube recorded eight solo tackles and assisted on 10 others, including 5.5 tackles-for-loss and a sack.

Sophomore Mike Maxwell tallied 10 tackles and had an interception while Paul Titchenell added a pair of sacks.

The Red Devils held Grove City to just 62 yards on the ground and scoreless for the entire fourth quarter to secure the win.

Special Teams

The Red Devil special teams played a major role on Saturday. Ben Hargrave received credit for the blocked punt that led to the Devils' go-ahead touchdown in the third. He was one of a pack of Red Devils that broke through on punter Chris Haley.

Brian Bruggar tallied a block on Grove City's extra-point attempt in the third quarter.

Dickinson's veteran punter Aren Johnson averaged 37.5 yards per kick, preventing the Wolverines from enjoying good field position all afternoon.

Scouting Hobart - The Statesmen are coming off their third straight NCAA playoff appearance, finishing 8-2 overall and 5-1 in the Liberty League to claim a share of the conference title.

They return 26 letterwinners and 12 starters from 2006.
