Setting the Stage – The Red Devils survived the Centennial Conference battle of unbeaten teams last weekend, escaping the Greyhounds of Moravian 24-23. First-year Gordon Craig split the uprights from 32 yards out with just six seconds on the clock with the game-winning field-goal. Dickinson improves to 5-0 overall and 3-0 in the CC. The 5-0 start is the Devils’ first since 1994.

Johns Hopkins comes in with an overall mark of 1-4. The Blue Jays are in the midst of a four-game stint against opponents with a combined record of 16-2. Muhlenberg remained the CC’s only other unbeaten team with a 28-21 victory over Hopkins last weekend.

Last Week - The game that featured two unbeaten teams lived up to its billing, coming down to a last second field-goal. The Greyhounds burned a pair of timeouts in hopes of rattling rookie kicker Gordon Craig. That was not the case as Craig calmly split the sticks from 32 yards away to keep the Devils undefeated at 5-0.

Moravian pulled in front 24-14 on a 30-yard field-goal by Brian Reckenbeil to start the fourth quarter. Sophomore quarterback Ian Mitchell connected with classmate Pat O’Connor for a 20-yard touchdown, O’Connor’s second of the afternoon with 8:57 remaining.

The teams traded punts, giving Moravian the ball with just over three minutes remaining on the game. The Dickinson defense came up huge as senior Ryan Heinig picked-off a pass at midfield with 2:36 on the clock. Mitchell completed 5-of-5 passes to drive the Devils to the 15 yard line to set up Craig’s game-winning field-goal.

Johns Hopkins leads the conference in red-zone offense, scoring on 13-of-14 trips inside the 20. Unfortunately that has not been enough as the Blue Jays have dropped four straight games for the first time since 1999.

Last Year - Dickinson scored a touchdown in each of the final three quarters to hold off the Blue Jays 21-13. The Devils struck first but watched JHU score on a 63-yard pass, followed by a 48-yard field-goal to lead 10-7 at halftime.

Michael D’Amico and Matt Torchia scored to match a another long field-goal by Hopkins and give the Devils the win. Torchia threw for 144 yards, reaching the century mark for the ninth straight game.

Ryan Heinig had a big game, making two key plays in the final minutes. He tallied seven tackles, a pair of breakups and an interception. Tredell Johns added a pair of sacks.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, ‘77) holds a 92-56-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux’s direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college’s only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux’s teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game is the 61st meeting with Johns Hopkins holding a slim 29-27-4 advantage in the series. The teams have traded wins over the last four seasons. Dickinson won five straight from 1997-2001, including a two in overtime at Biddle Field.

Offense - The Red Devils relied on a complete team effort to knock-off conference newcomer Moravian College last weekend. There were also some outstanding individual efforts along the way as well.

Sophomore quarterback Ian Mitchell completed 21-of-29 passes for 230 yards and a touchdown. He completed 5-of-5 on the game-winning drive and rushed for 39 yards.

Senior Chris McInerney caught 11 passes for 95 yards on the day. He also threw a 23-yard touchdown strike to Patrick O'Connor in the second quarter. O'Connor finished with 117 yards and two touchdowns while McInerney tallied 203 all-purpose yards. He leads the CC in all-purpose gains, averaging 150.6 ypg.

The Devils rank second in the Centennial in both scoring and rushing offense, averaging 27.2 points and 177.6 yards on the ground.

Defense - Eric Dube and Ben Hargrave continued to be a constant presence on the defensive side of the ball. Dube went over the 300 mark for career tackles, recording 13 on Saturday, including six solo and 1.5 for losses. Hargrave was in on nine tackles.

Ryan Heinig posted seven solo tackles, forced a fumble and intercepted a pass that led to the Devils game-winning drive. Heinig leads the conference in passes defended with 10.

Eric Hertrich came up with a big sack in the second half while Steve Bokron made a pair of critical tackles on Moravian's final drive.

The Devils intercepted a pair of passes and forced a fumble on Saturday. They have won the turnover battle in each of their first five games this season. Dickinson ranks second in the CC in turnover-margin at (+7).

The Devils rank second in the CC in rushing defense (98.4 ypg) and third in scoring defense (20.8 ppg).

Special Teams - First-year Gordon Craig earned CC Special Teams Player of the Week honors for his performance on Saturday. Following back-to-back Moravian timeouts, the rookie split the uprights from 32 yards out. It was the second game-winning field-goal for Dickinson this season.

Aren Johnson is fourth in the CC for punting, averaging 37.8 yards. He has dropped 5-of-28 inside the 20 and has a long of 56 yards this season.

Chris McInerney leads the CC in all-purpose yards with 150.6 per game. He ranks in the top three for both kick-off and punt returns.

Scouting Johns Hopkins - The Blue Jays may be 1-4 on the season but they have played some quality teams over the first half of the season.

They have dropped four straight for the first time since 1999.

Running back Andrew Kase reached the century mark for the second straight game, rushing for 140 yards against Muhlenberg. WR Corey Sattler had a career-high 119 yards receiving last week, putting him over the 1,000-yard mark for his career.

Linbacker Colin Wexted leads the conference in tackles-for-loss with 9.5. The Blue Jay defense ranks third against the pass, allowing 180.8 yards per game.

JHU will also feature a first-year kicker in Alex Lachman. He ranks second in the CC in scoring and field-goals made, going 10-for-10 on extra-points and 6-for-6 on field-goals.
