Setting the Stage – The Red Devils and the Eagles meet for the sixth straight year but for the first time as Centennial Conference opponents. The Devils have won four straight against Juniata to take a 10-8 lead in the series. The Devils suffered a 29-24 setback at unbeaten Muhlenberg last week, slipping to third in the conference standings. Juniata fell to 0-8 on the year with a 42-21 loss to Johns Hopkins.

Last Week - Muhlenberg spotted the Devils a 17-0 advantage last week before regrouping to score 23 unanswered points. The Devils scored with 7:05 remaining to regain the lead but the Mules struck again with 3:27, converting a fourth down into a 29-24 lead. Four turnovers proved to be costly as Muhlenberg started with good field position all afternoon.

Tim Smith scored twice in the first quarter and Gordon Craig kicked a 24-yard field-goal to put the Devils in front 17-0. Muhlenberg capitalized on a fumble and an interception as Jordon Grube kicked a 24-yard field-goal and Eric Santagato threw a pair of 20-yard touchdown passes. A missed extra-point kept a 17-16 lead in the hands of the Devils as the teams went into halftime.

Santagato sandwiched two more TD passes around an Ian Mitchell score for the final of 29-24.

Chris McNerney caught nine passes for 83 yards as Mitchell completed 12-of-23 passes for 100 yards.

Eric Dube earned Defensive Player of the Week honors with a game-high 14 tackles, including eight solo stops and a tackle-for-loss. Mike O'Donnell made six tackles, including three-for-losses and broke up three passes. Michael Dalton recovered a fumble, blocked a kick and broke up two passes as well.

Last Year- The Devils opened the 2006 campaign with a muddy 14-0 victory over the Eagles. Matt Torchia threw a pair of touchdown passes to Chris McNerney for the only scores of the game. The Devils rushed for 157 yards and Torchia completed 10-of-12 passes for 101 yards, including 4-for-62 to McNerney.

Andrew Ackley posted a game-high 12 tackles and picked-off his 16th career interception. It was his sixth career interception against Juniata. Eric Dube tallied 11 tackles on the day while senior Ryne Cantwell was just shy of the century mark with 97 yards.

The Devils won their fourth straight season opener, their eighth in the last nine seasons.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 93-58-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game marks the 19th meeting between the Eagles and the Red Devils. Dickinson holds a 10-8 advantage, winning the last four games. The teams renewed the series in 2002 after last playing in 1956.

Offense - Sophomore Ian Mitchell ran for 69 yards and a touchdown, and threw for 100 yards on Saturday. He leads the Devils in rushing (646) and passing (1,062), looking to become just the sixth Centennial quarterback to lead his team in both categories.

Mitchell ranks fourth on the single season list for total offense with 1,708 yards. He is currently 11th with 1,062 passing yards.

Senior Chris McInerney caught nine passes for 83 yards last week. He set the school single season record with 59 catches this fall. He moved into fifth all-time with 1,400 receiving yards. He also ranks fifth with 3,088 all-purpose yards.

Tim Smith is second on the team in rushing with 436 yards and five touchdowns. Sophomore Tim Wells is averaging 4.5 yards per carry and leads the team with eight touchdowns.

Defense - Senior captain Eric Dube has had another outstanding season at linebacker. He was named the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week for his performance at Muhlenberg last week. He tallied a game-high 14 tackles, including eight solo stops and one tackle-for-loss. He leads the CC with 112 tackles this season, ranking third on the Dickinson single season top 10 list. He finished with 120 tackles in 2006, just two shy of Bob Schnarrs' school record 122.

Michael O'Donnell and A.J. Reising each tallied five solo tackles on Saturday. O'Donnell added three tackles-for-loss and three pass break-ups against the Mules. Michael Dalton blocked a punt and also recovered a fumble.

The Red Devils held Muhlenberg to just 96 yards rushing, almost 100 yards under their season average. They rank third in the CC in rushing and scoring defense, and second in turnover margin at (+6).

Special Teams - McInerney went over the 600 yard mark for punt return yardage. He ranks second all-time in that category. He ranks fifth in kick-off returns with 950 yards.

Aren Johnson went over the 7,000 yard mark, punting 200 times in his career for a school record 7,123 yards.

Scouting Juniata - Junior Jay Leonard (Newville, PA/Big Spring) became the fifth Juniata QB to throw for over 5,000 yards. The Eagles lead the CC in passing offense at 240.1 ypg. Lance Tippett leads the conference, averaging 93.8 ypg.

Josh Roy is second in the CC with 87 tackles.
