Setting the Stage – Dickinson plays host to McDaniel College this weekend. The Red Devils improved to 3-0 on the season with a 28-21 win under the lights at Franklin & Marshall. The Green Terror fell by an identical score to Catholic University, slipping to 0-3 on the season.

Last Week- The Red Devils traveled to Lancaster for a rare Friday night game under the lights at Franklin & Marshall. Both teams came out firing, putting 21 points on the board in the opening five minutes. The Devils sandwiched a pair of long touchdown passes around a 17-yard strike from F&M to lead 14-7 at the end of the first quarter.

The Devils did the same in the second to lead 28-14 at halftime. The defenses took center stage in the second half as both teams went scoreless in the third period. The Diplomats punched the ball into the endzone with 10:11 remaining to pull within a touchdown. The Devils pinned F&M on the two yard-line, then intercepted a pass two plays later. They later held on a 4th-and-2 and then converted on a 4th-and-6 to secure the win.

The teams combined for 848 yards of total offense on the night.

The Devils also retained possession of the Conestoga Wagon Trophy for the fourth straight year.

Last Year - The Red Devils amassed 356 yards of offense in a 24-17 win over the Green Terror. Matt Torchia completed 16-of-24 passes for 157 yards. He tossed a 21-yard touchdown pass to Michael D'Amico in the second quarter and ran for another score in the third.

Chris McInerney caught five passes for 89 yards and added 113 yards on four kick-off returns. He caught a 27-yard TD pass from Ian Mitchell as well.

Eric Dube posted a game-high 13 tackles, including seven solo and three-for-losses. Ryan Heinig and Ryan Anderson each added six tackles.

McDaniel was the first team, and one of just four on the year to rush for over 100 yards, running for 104 on the day. Green Terror QB Brad Baer three for 129 yards and two scores to Matt Gingrich.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 90-56-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game marks the 63rd meeting between the two teams. McDaniel holds a 35-26-1 lead but have dropped the last two match-ups with the Devils. The Green Terror looks for win number 500 while head coach Tim Keating looks to step closer to the century mark with a 95-51-3 mark in 14 seasons with the Green Terror. He is 121-74-3 overall.

The Offense - Sophomore quarterback Ian Mitchell turned in another exciting and outstanding performance under the Friday night lights at Franklin & Marshall. He completed his first 10 passes, connecting with senior Chris McInerney for a 54-yard touchdown on the game's first play from scrimmage.

He went on to rush for 130 yards and one touchdown while throwing for 177 yards and two scores. He tossed a 46 yard scoring strike to Pat O'Connor and also caught a 17-yard pass from McInerney off a reverse.

McInerney caught eight passes for 83 yards on the night while O'Connor tallied 76 yards on five receptions.

Tim Smith covered 50 yards on seven carries and Tim Wells ran for 40 yards and a touchdown.

Overall the Devils totaled 249 yard rushing and 194 through the air.

Defense - Right from the start it was apparent the Diplomats had very little intention of running the football against the Devil defense. They threw nine straight passes to get to the endzone on their first drive.

The Devils held F&M to just 77 yards rushing, and despite allowing 328 through the air, picked-off three passes and held F&M scoreless throughout the third quarter.

Senior linebacker Eric Dube was again a force, recording a game-high 15 tackles. He tallied seven solo stops, recovered a fumble and broke up a pass.

He leads the Centennial, averaging 17 tackles per game, and is tied for the top spot with 6.5 tackles-for-loss.

In the secondary Michael Maxwell leads the CC with three interceptions after picking-off F&M twice on Friday night. He is third in pass breakups, behind teammate

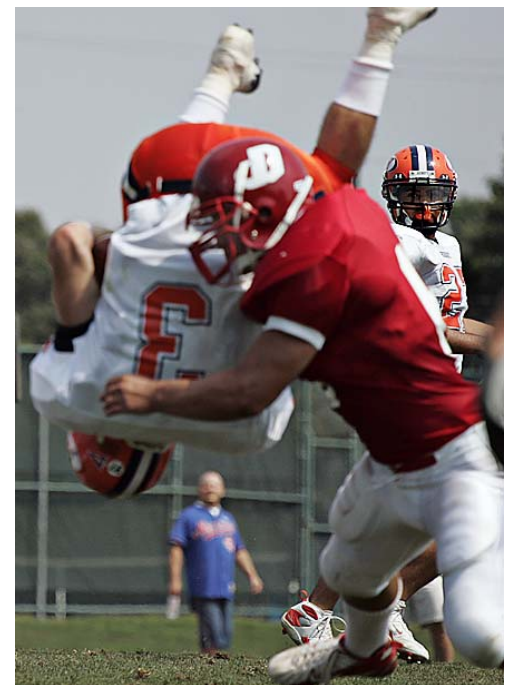
Ryan Heinig, who holds the top spot with six breakups.

Michael Dalton added an interception on Friday as well while Tredell Johns added two tackles-for-loss, a sack and force a fumble.

Special Teams - Senior punter Aren Johnson has been solid through the first three games, averaging 40.8 yards per kick to rank second in the CC. He's dropped 4-of-15 inside the 20, placing one on the two-yardline at F&M.

McInerney ranks in the top four in the CC for both kick-off and punt returns, along with repetitions and reception yards.

Junior Matt Stark is 5-of-6 on extra-points and 2-for-4 on field-goal attempts while first-year Gordon Craig has taken over kick-off duties.
