**Setting the Stage** - The Red Devils won their sixth straight season opener last weekend, turning back Grove City College 34-7. The Devils appeared to have no trouble adjusting to the newly renovated turf field, scoring 17 points in the second quarter to take a 24-0 advantage into halftime. After the break the Devils went to the ground, not attempting a single pass in the final 30 minutes. This week the Devils travel to non-conference rival Hobart College. The teams have played some exciting contests in recent years and 2007 was no exception. Matt Stark kicked a 37-yard field-goal to give the Devils a 30-27 win in overtime.

**Last Week** - The turf could not have come at a better time as the Devils opened the 2007 campaign in a constant driving rain last weekend. The weather did not appear to have much affect on the hosts as they struck once in the first quarter and tacked on 17 points in the second to take control of the game, 24-0 at halftime.

Sophomore running back Greg Lord rushed for a career and game-high 119 yards and three touchdowns on 19 carries. Junior quarterback Ian Mitchell completed 6-of-10 passes on the day, throwing for 110 yards, all in the first half. Classmate Pat O'Connor made three catches for 88 yards and returned three punts for 26 yards. Gordon Craig added field-goals from 27 and 28 yards, converting four extra-points on the afternoon.

On the defensive side it was a balanced effort as Dickinson held the Wolverines to just 50 yards rushing and 167 yards threw the air. Michael Dalton led the way with nine tackles while seniors Matt Stone and Ben Hargrave each tallied seven. Steve Bokron was in the backfield all afternoon, applying pressure while recording six tackles and a pair of sacks. Tredell Johns chipped in with a fumble recovery and Kevin Joy picked-off a pass for a 19-yard return.

**Last Year**- The Devils survived an overtime thriller in Carlisle a year ago. Will Scott returned a fumble 85 yards, followed by an Ian Mitchell two-point conversion to put the Devils on top 27-24 with just 46 seconds remaining. Hobart split the uprights with no time on the clock to force overtime. The defense held on the first possession before Matt Stark kicked a 36-yard field-goal to give the Devils the win.

Eric Dube recorded 18 tackles, including eight solo stops while Scott added 13 tackles and Ben Hargrave recorded 12. Mitchell ran for 119 yards while first-year Tim Smith covered 85 yards and scored a pair of touchdowns.

### The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 97-58-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

**The Series** - The Devils meet the Statesmen for the 18th time with the Devils holding a slim 9-7-1 advantage in the series. The teams traded thrilling home victories in the last two meetings as Dickinson won the 2007 match-up 30-27 in overtime. Hobart returns 13 starters this season as they open this week against the Devils.

**The Offense** - The Red Devils were efficient and effective on offense last week, jumping out to a 24-0 lead at halftime. Junior quarterback Ian Mitchell looked sharp, completing 6-of-10 passes for 110 yards. Pat O'Connor was on the receiving end of three passes for 88 yards. That all occurred in the first half as the Devils went strictly to the ground in the second half.

Mitchell rushed for 51 yards as well, breaking once for 47 yards and scoring on a 22 yard run. Sophomore Greg Lord covered a game and career-high 119 yards, scoring three touchdowns on 19 carries. Tim Wells, Matt Manganaro and Tim Smith also ran well for the Devils, showing significant depth in the backfield.

**Defense** - The Devils lost some key veterans to graduation but that did not seem to phase the defensive unit much at all in Saturday's opener. The Dickinson secondary did not give Grove City's school record holding quarterback many options, forcing the Wolverines to run the football. The front line was in the backfield all afternoon, stopping the run and also applying pressure to QB Andrew DiDonato with three sacks.

Linebackers Ben Hargrave, Cole Glennon and Kevin Wood anchored a solid defensive effort as Dickinson held the Wolverine offense in check for the better part of the afternoon. Hargrave tallied seven tackles, Wood six and Glennon added a sack.

The Devils recorded six tackles-for-loss, holding Grove City to 50 yards rushing and 167 in the air. Kevin Joy returned and interception 19 yards and Tredell Johns recovered a fumble.

**Special Teams** - Gordon Craig split the uprights from 27 and 28 yards, and converted four extra-points on the day. Matt Stark averaged just under 35 yards on three punts.

O'Connor and Lord were impressive returning kicks while the kick-off team pinned the Wolverines on the eight yard-line early in the second quarter.

**Scouting Hobart** - This marks the season opener for Hobart. The Statesmen return 13 starters from a team that went 8-3 in 2007 and earned a bid to the NCAA playoffs.

The Statesmen return four starters, including three All-Conference selections to the offensive line. They look to open the way for running backs Anthony Hobaica and sophomore Andrew Marlier. Hobaica led Hobart with

605 yards and seven touchdowns last season. Hobart lost two of its top receivers but will look to juniors Tyler Vincent and Zach Schulz to fill the void at that position.

The strong point of the Hobart defense appears to be in the talent and depth of the line. The Statesmen return senior tackles Ryan Aruck and junior Mike Faracca to the line-up. Hobart also features four All-Liberty League selections at linebacker in senior Jeff Sanders, senior Justin Hager, junior Ryan Robinson, and sophomore Kyle O'Laughlin.

The Statesmen allowed the fewest passing yards per game (158.6) and posted the lowest pass efficiency defense rating (92.4) in the Liberty League in 2007. Senior free safety Lance Boyington will lead the secondary.
