**Setting the Stage** - The Red Devils regrouped last week to knock off previously unbeaten Moravian College 16-7. The conference race looks like it could be a tight one with nationally-ranked Muhlenberg on top at 2-0 . The Devils head to Baltimore for their second game under the lights this season. Home field has not proven to be an advantage in the series lately with the road team winning the last five meetings.

**Last Week** - The Devils played one of the fastest games in school history, ending in just two hours and 12 minutes. The Red Devils were all business last week, using a balanced attack to knock the Greyhounds from the ranks of unbeaten teams with a 16-7 decision.

Pat O'Connor caught seven passes for 129 yards and both Red Devil touchdowns. He finished with 106 yards on the day as the Devils have had a 100-yard rusher in all five games this fall. Ian Mitchell connected with O'Connor for a pair of 22 yard touchdowns. He finished with 132 yards passing and ran for another 39.

Seniors Ben Hargrave and Tredell Johns anchored a solid defensive effort as the Devils forced five turnovers and held the Greyhounds to just 173 yards of total offense. Johns was named the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week. He recorded 10 tackles, forced one fumble, recovered another and had an interception. Hargrave tallied a game-high 13 tackles, including 1.5 tackles-for-loss. Kevin Wood added eight tackles, five solos, a 14-yard sack and a forced fumble as well.

The Blue Jays rallied but came up short against #5-ranked Muhlenberg last weekend. Rookie QB Hewitt Tomlin posted the best statistical performance by a conference first-year, covering 377 yards of total offense. He connected with classmate Sam Wernick five times for a conference freshman record of 205 yards. He caught touchdowns of 91 and 81 yards. Andrew Kase rushed of 128 yards, his thrid straight 100-yard game.

**Last Year** - Alex Lachman hit a 40 yard field-goal as time expired to trip up the Devils 20-17 last fall. He connected late in the first half to give the Blue Jays a 17-7 lead at halftime. The Devils answered with a Tim Wells TD and Gordon Craig tied the game with a 44 yard field-goal to start the fourth quarter.

Mitchell ran for 137 yards and passed for 136 while Chris McInerney tallied 148 all-purpose yards. Eric Dube led the defense with a game-high 12 tackles. Ben Hargrave added 11 tackles and Will Scott made seven solo stops, an interception and two pass breakups.

## The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 99-60-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

**The Series** - The Devils meet the Blue Jays for the 67th time with JHU holding a 30-27-4 advantage in the series. The visitors have won the last five meetings while the Devils are 4-1 in their last five trips to Homewood Field.

**Offense** - Ian Mitchell raised his career numbers to 1,216 yards rushing and moved into eighth all-time at Dickinson with 2,283 passing yards. He ranks third in career total offense with 3,499 yards. His rushing yards rank him fifth all-time among Centennial Conference quarterbacks. Dickinson alum John Tice ranks fourth on that list with 1,264 yards.

Mitchell has completed 61.5 percent of his passes this season, covering 811 yards.

Classmate Pat O'Connor already ranks 10th on the single season list for receiving yards, moving into ninth on the all-time school list with 578 yards for a total of 1,223.

Tim Wells went over the century mark on Saturday, rushing for 106 yards on 24 carries.

The Red Devils rank second in the CC for rushing offense, and third in total offense and passing efficiency. They lead the league in fourth-down conversions and also in sacks against, allowing just one so far this season.

**Defense** - Tredell Johns earned Player of the Week honors for his part in the win over Moravian College. He tallied 10 tackles, forced a fumble, recovered another and intercepted a pass. He went over the century mark for career tackles with 103. He is just 11 shy of his single season best of 44 tackles in 2007.

The Devils held Moravian to just 106 yards rushing last week. They lead the CC in rushing defense, allowing just 87.4 yards per game. The Devils rank second in total defense and sacks, and third in both scoring and pass defense.

Senior captain Ben Hargrave is second in the conference with a team-best 56 tackles on the year. He ranks seventh in tackles-for-loss with five. Johns is second in tackles-for-loss with 6.5 and third in sacks in the CC with 3.5 this fall.

Sophomore linebacker Kevin Wood turned in a solid performance last week as well. He tallied eight tackles, a sack and forced a fumble. He is second on the team with 41 tackles and is tied with Johns with two forced fumbles.

**Scouting Hopkins** - Look up in the sky... Friday night could showcase some aerial fireworks as two of the top receivers in the CC square-off in Baltimore. O'Connor will be the primary target for the Devils while JHU rookie WR Sam Wernick ranks right behind O'Connor in receiving yards per game. Wernick caught TD strikes of 81 and 91 yards last week, finishing with 205 yards on just five catches.

Rookie QB Hewitt Tomlin and Wernick could do a lot of damage over the next three and a half years. Tomlin turned in the best statistical performance by a rookie in conference history last weekend. He accounted for 377 total yards of offense, throwing for 387 on the day.

Andrew Kase rushed for 128 yards last week. He is 102 yards away from being the 10th CC back to reach the 2,000 yard mark, in just his junior season.

Place kicker Alex Lachman is a perfect 4-1 of 41 on extra-points in his career.
