**Setting the Stage** - The Red Devils stayed right with #2-ranked Muhlenberg last week, but the unbeaten Mules held on for a thrilling 31-25 win last week. The Devils look to rebound this week on the road at Juniata. The Eagles come into the game with a 1-8 record, but have proven to be a dangerous opponent this fall. The Eagles went three overtimes with second-place Moravian two weeks ago before falling 23-17.

**Lat Week** - The Mules put up 21 points in the second quarter and looked to be taking control of the game. A Red Devil field-goal, a blocked punt for a safety and last minute touchdown by junior quarterback Ian Mitchell cut the Muhlenberg lead to 21-19 at halftime.

The defenses dominated a scoreless third quarter. Erik Snyder stretched the Mules' lead to 28-19 midway through the fourth. Tim Wells broke free for a 31 yard touchdown to pull the Devils within in field-goal. The Devils recovered a fumble on the ensuing kick-off but the Mules held and tacked on a field-goal with 2:23 remaining in the game.

The Devils were driving in the final seconds but were stopped on fourth down as the Mules held on for their eighth win of the season.

Juniata surrendered yards but not many points in a 12-0 loss at Johns Hopkins. Jordan Baird set an NCAA record, forcing four fumbles in the game. He recovered one as well in addition to nine solo and 11 overall tackles. Local Jay Leonard (Newville, PA/Big Spring) went over 7,000 yards of total offense. He needs 320 in his final outing to break the school's career record.

**Last Year** - The Red Devils amassed 493 yards of offense en route to a 41-14 win at Biddle Field. Ian Mitchell completed 14-of-16 passes for 246 yards and four touchdowns. Chris McInerney was on the receiving end of three touchdown passes, finishing with nine receptions for 128 yards. Pat O'Connor covered 120 yards on four catches, including one for a score.

Will Scott tallied seven tackles, five solos, and returned a punt 57 yards to the Juniata one yard line. Eric Dube and Paul Titchenell each had seven tackles as well while Dube added 2.5 tackles for loss and forced a fumble.

Jay Leonard completed 19-of-46 passes for 271 yards. Lance Tippett caught five passes for 131 yards on the day.

## The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 100-62-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

**The Series** - The Devils meet the Eagles for the 20th time with Dickinson holding a 11-8 advantage in the series, winning the last five matchups. The Eagles' last win came in Huntingdon with a 26-9 decision in 2002.

**Offense** - Junior Ian Mitchell became just the second Dickinson quarterback to throw for over 1,500 yards in a season and is just shy of going over 3,000 yards in his career. Mitchell currently ranks third all-time with 2,979 passing yards, and ranks second in total offense with 4,408.

The offensive line has been solid all season, allowing Mitchell and the Red Devils to effectively move the football. The Devils lead the conference in sacks against, allowing just five all season. The Devils rank third in rushing offense and fourth in passing. They rank second in the Red Zone, scoring just under 75 percent of the time.

Classmate Pat O'Connor has played a key role as one of Mitchell's favorite targets, catching 64 passes for a school record 1,039 yards this season. He ranks second in career receiving with 1,684 yards on 105 receptions. He leads the CC this season in receptions, receiving yards and all-purpose yards.

Sophomore Greg Lord is the Devils top rusher, averaging 65 yards per game to rank eighth in the CC. Mitchell and fullback Tim Wells are 10th and 11th in the CC, both over 50 yards per outing.

**Defense** - Following an explosive start by Muhlenberg the Devils settled in and held the second-ranked Mules scoreless for almost three quarters on Saturday. Facing one of the biggest offensive lines in the country, the Devils held their own, keeping the game within striking distance right down to the final possession.

The Devils rank third in the conference in passing defense and fourth in scoring and total defense. The Devils are tied with Moravian with a conference-best 20 sacks on the year.

Tredell Johns and Cole Glennon lead the team, each with 3.5 sacks this season. Ben Hargrave ranks third in the CC with 79 tackles while Kevin Wood is fifth 71 total stops.

The Devils recorded three sacks against the Mules, adding an additional four tackles-for-loss in the game.

**Special Teams** - The special teams did all they could to keep the Devils in the hunt on Saturday. Junior Gray Gish blocked a punt into the endzone, resulting in a safety and sophomore Pat McNeal recovered a fumble on a kick-off late in the game. Sophomore kicker Gordon Craig kicked a 26 yard field-goal while O'Connor covered 95 yards on kick-off returns.

**Scouting Juniata** - Don't let the record fool you. Juniata has turned in some strong performances this season. Josh Roy and Tyler Hall rank second and fourth in the CC for tackles. Jordan Baird and Hall have each forced four fumbles on the year.

QB Jay Leonard has had a great career and is closing in on the school record for total offense.
