**Setting the Stage** - The Red Devils opened the Centennial Conference schedule with a 34-20 win over Franklin & Marshall last week, in the 100th meeting between the schools. The game was the first ever under the lights at Biddle Field and marked the 1,000th game in program history. This week Dickinson travels to McDaniel College for the 64th meeting with the Green Terror. McDaniel brings a 1-2 record into Saturday's contest, coming off a 31-7 loss on the road at Catholic.

**Last Week** - A slow start didn't stop the Devils after falling behind Franklin & Marshall 6-0 in the first quarter last week. Dickinson rattled off 21 points in the second frame to take a 21-13 lead into halftime. F&M's George Eager scored his second TD of the night to pull the Diplomats within one, 21-20, on the first drive of the second half.

Gregory Lord capped a pair of long drives in the fourth quarter with touchdowns to secure the win for the Red Devils. Lord reached the century mark for the third straight week and scored three TDs for the second time this year. Junior QB Ian Mitchell threw for 245 yards as classmate Pat O'Connor tied the school record with 12 catches. O'Connor posted the third highest single game total with 161 receiving yards.

Ben Hargrave tallied a team-best 12 tackles, including two for losses, while Tredell Johns recorded a pair of key sacks in the second half.

McDaniel spoiled the shutout with 28 seconds remaining last week as Zach Swope connected with Woody Butler on a 5-yard pass. The Green Terror held Catholic to just 58 yards rushing but surrendered 353 yards through the air. T.J. Devlin rushed for 74 yards to lead the offense. Travis Wenrich picked-off his second pass of the season.

**Last Year** - Three different backs scored in the opening quarter to put the Devils on top 19-0. Tim Smith put the Devils on the board with a 17-yard run before fullback Tim Wells and Mitchell each scored from three yards out. Chris McInerney added a 57-yard punt return for six points and linebacker Michael O'Donnell returned an interception, his second of the game, into the endzone from 25 yards out. Gordon Craig tacked on a 28-yard field-goal for the Devils as well. Ben Hargrave led the defense with a game-high 14 tackles.

Eric Zwilsky rushed for three touchdowns on the day to lead McDaniel.

### The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 98-58-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

**The Series** - The Devils meet the Green Terror for the 64th time in the series. McDaniel leads the series 35-27-1 but the Devils have claimed victories in the last three outings, snapping a nine-game streak for the Terror.

**Offense** - It took a little time to get the motor running on Friday night as the capacity crowd appeared to be on the minds of the Devils in the first night game at Biddle. Once the Devils embraced the atmosphere they were able to rattle off 21 points in the second quarter en route to a 34-20 victory in the Conestoga Wagon Rivalry Game.

Sophomore running back Gregory Lord reached the century mark for the third straight week, rushing for 115 yards and three touchdowns. It was the second hat-trick for Lord, who now has eight touchdowns in three games.

Junior quarterback Ian Mitchell continues to raise his career numbers and improve on his fundraising efforts with increasing support from fans and opponents alike. Mitchell receives donations for every yard he gains on the football field. All proceeds are donated to charity to support families affected by cancer. Mitchell has been a valuable resource, rushing for 1,046 yards and throwing for over 2,000 yards, primarily in just the past two seasons.

One of Mitchell's favorite targets is classmate Pat O'Connor. O'Connor tied a school record with 12 receptions last week. He tallied the third-highest single game total in school history with 161 yards. He has caught 62 passes for 995 yards in his career.

The Devils rank second in the CC in rushing and total offense. O'Connor leads the conference in repetitions and yards per game. Lord is third in the CC for rushing, averaging 113.3 yards per game.

**Defense** - The Red Devils rank second in the CC in rushing defense, holding teams to just 74.3 yards per game on the ground. The Devils top the conference in red-zone defense at 50 percent.

Senior captain Ben Hargrave leads the Devils with 27 tackles on the year and ranks seventh with 3.5 tackles for loss. Classmate Tredell Johns is second in the CC with 3.5 sacks. He dropped F&M quarterback John Harrison twice in the second half on Friday night to help the Devils stall the Diplomat offense for the final 26 minutes.

Matt Stone was a thorn in Harrison's side as well, recording a sack and returning an interception 12 yards as F&M was threatening deep in Red Devil territory. Michael Maxwell picked-off a pass in the endzone late in the fourth quarter. That closed the door on F&M as the Devils took a pair of knees to run out the clock.

**Special Teams** - O'Connor covered 51 yards on three kick-off returns last week. He has returned five kicks for 109 yards this season. Gordon Craig went 4-for-5 on extra-points last week. That was his first miss in 12 attempts this season.

**Scouting McDaniel** - The 1-2 Green Terror are still trying to find the right combination in Westminster. Zach Swope threw a touchdown pass last week but is not listed on the depth chart for week four. Matt Cahill has had the hot hand receiving as all five catches have gone for either a first-down or touchdown.

Travis Wenrich has a pair of interceptions on the year while Mike Weick leads McDaniel with 24 tackles.
