**Setting the Stage** - The Red Devils meet the Diplomats for the 100th time in the Centennial Conference's oldest rivalry. There is much history surrounding this week's game as it marks the 1000th in the history of the program, and will be the first night game hosted on Biddle Field. Both teams suffered tough losses in week two as the Devils dropped a heartbreaker at Hobart 28-21 and the Diplomats fell to Catholic 14-7.

**Last Week** - The Red Devils rallied from a 14-0 halftime deficit to pull in front of Hobart 21-14 late in the fourth quarter. The Statesmen battled back, scoring twice in the final 3:21 to take a 28-21 advantage with just 54 seconds remaining in the game. Dickinson drove to the Hobart 25 yard line but were unable to reach the endzone to score the equalizer.

Sophomore running back Greg Lord came on strong in the second half, rushing for 106 yards and two touchdowns on the afternoon. Junior quarterback Ian Mitchell completed 14-of-23 passes for 176 yards while rushing for 62 yards on 11 attempts. He connected with classmate Pat O'Connor on six occasions, covering 101 yards, including a 20 yard strike to put the Devils in front 21-14. Tim Smith tacked on 48 yards rushing on 18 carries.

Tredell Johns anchored a solid and balanced defensive effort, recording seven tackles, including five solo stops and 1.5 sacks for losses of 10 yards. Ben Hargrave, Kevin Wood and Michael Maxwell each tallied eight tackles. Wood forced a fumble as well, as did Matt Stone. The Devils were strong against the run, holding Hobart to just 97 yards rushing.

**Last Year** - Under the lights on a rainy, misty night in Lancaster the Red Devils won an offensive shootout 28-21 as quarterbacks Kyle Turner and Mitchell went head-to-head.

The teams combined for 848 yards of offense as Mitchell completed his first 10 passes en route to 177 yards and two touchdowns through the air. He rushed for another 130 yards and one touchdown as well. Chris McInerney caught eight passes for 83 yards while Pat O'Connor made five receptions for 76 yards.

The defense held F&M to just 77 yards rushing and picked-off three passes, holding the Diplomats scoreless for the final 36 minutes of the game. Eric Dube led the way with 15 tackles, seven solo, a fumble recovery and a pass breakup. Maxwell recorded two of the Devils' three interceptions on the night.

## The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 97-58-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

**The Series** - The Devils meet the Diplomats for the 100th time in the Centennial Conference's oldest rivalry. The game also marks the 1,000th in the history of the program at Dickinson College as the Devils kick-off under the lights of Biddle Field for the first time.

The Diplomats lead the overall series 59-37-3 and hold a 26-19-1 advantage in Carlisle. Also on the line are possession and bragging rights for the Conestago Wagon Trophy. F&M leads the series for the Wagon 25-20 but have not won at Biddle since 1998.

**Offense** - The Devils struggled to put points on the board early in the game against Hobart but came alive in the second half. Sophomore Greg Lord reached the century mark for the second straight week, rushing for 106 yards on 19 carries, scoring a pair of touchdowns to give him five on the young season.

Ian Mitchell completed 14-of-23 passes for 176 yards. He connected with Pat O'Connor for six receptions for 101 yards and the Devils' go ahead touchdown on Saturday. O'Connor ranks second in the CC in receiving with nine catches for 189 yards, averaging just under 100 yards per game. He also ranks fourth in the conference for all-purpose yards while Lord ranks fifth.

Mitchell ran for 62 yards on Saturday. He ranks fourth in the CC in total offense, averaging 199.5 yards per game.

The Devils rank second in the conference in rushing offense and are tied for the top spot in pass protection, allowing just one sack this season.

**Defense** - Balance has been the key for the Devil defense in its first two outings this season. Dickinson leads the CC in rushing defense, allowing just 73.5 yards per game in the past two contests.

Senior Ben Hargrave has led the way with 15 tackles this fall while Maxwell is second on the team with 14 and sophomore Kevin Wood has tallied 13 in the past two games.

Tredell Johns recorded five solo tackles at Hobart, finishing with seven on the day to go with 1.5 sacks.

**Special Teams**- Sophomore Gordon Craig is currently 7-for-7 on extra-points and has convertend 2-of-3 field-goal attempts this fall. Senior Matt Stark is third in the CC in punting, averaging 37.3 yards per kick on the year.

**Scouting F&M** - The Diplomats have first-year quarterback John Harrison running the offense this season. He completed 20-of-34 passes for 216 yards and one touchdown against Catholic. George Eager made seven catches while former high school teammate Jay Ridinger added five on Saturday.

Zach Romash led the defense with 12 tackles on Saturday. Jeff Kellar made eight stops and had an interception.
