Setting the Stage - The Red Devils made a furious comeback at Johns Hopkins two weeks ago, falling just two-points shy of tying the game in the final minutes. The Devils are in the middle of a dogfight in the Centennial Conference with league leader Muhlenberg holding on to first with a 4-0 mark. The Devils welcome Gettysburg to Biddle Field for the 74th meeting between the teams. The Bullets have won three straight after opening the season 0-4.

Last Time Out - The Devils were idle last week, following a heartbreaker at Johns Hopkins on the previous Friday. The Devils spotted the Blue Jays a 33-0 lead before making a miraculous attempt to claw back into the game. The Devils scored late in the third quarter and put up 27 points in the final 10 minutes to cut the deficit to 36-34. Hopkins was able to break up the two-point conversion attempt and held on for the win.

Pat O'Connor and Ian Mitchell put up some huge numbers in effort as O'Connor set three school records in the process. The junior wide receiver tied his own school mark of 12 catches, covering a school record 248 yards in the game. He became the first Dickinson receiver to go over 200 yards in a single game. He tallied 148 yards on returns to set a school record with 396 all-purpose yards. Mitchell threw for a career-high 323 yards, throwing four touchdown passes and running for a fifth in the second half.

Ben Hargrave had a monster game defensively, recording a career-best 19 tackles. A.J. Reisig and Michael Dalton recorded 14 and 13 tackles, respectively, while Kevin Wood and Michael Maxwell each recovered a fumble to go with eight stops.

Gettysburg posted its third straight win, defeating Juniata 24-20. Matt Flynn recorded 222 yards of total offense while Nick McConnell rushed for a career-best 149 yards and two touchdowns. Tim Widdoes recorded nine tackles and recovered a fumble. Josh Jerrold added a sack, forced a fumble, broke up a pass and blocked a kick.

Last Year - Dickinson scored three touchdowns in a span of three minutes to take control last fall. Ryan Heinig blocked a punt that was recovered in the endzone by Michael Dalton. Chris McInerney added a 51 yard punt return for a touchdown before a Heinig interception led to another score in a 42-28 victory.

McInerney finished with 10 catches for 88 yards and amassed 191 all-purpose yards while becoming the school's all-time reception leader. Eric Dube tallied a game-high 15 tackles, including nine solo stops and a forced fumble as he became the school's career leader in tackles.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 99-61-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

The Series - The Devils meet the Bullets for the 74th time in the series. Gettysburg holds a 40-31-2 lead while the Devils have the edge since the inception of the Little Brown Bucket 20-19-1. The Devils have claimed 11 of the last 12 meetings.

Offense - Pat O'Connor made a personal assault on the Dickinson College record book as he attempted to lead the Devils to one of the most incredible comebacks in program history two weeks ago.

In addition to tying the school mark for receptions in a game with 12, he broke school records for receiving yards in a game (248), all-purpose yards (396) and single season receiving yards with 826. He all-purpose yardage was also the second-best performance in Centennial Conference history as well.

It marked the second straight year the Devils had a receiver break the single season mark as Chris McInerney covered 750 yards in 2007.

O'Connor caught three touchdown passes, breaking a pair of tackles from 35 yards out to pull the Devils within two at 34-36 with just 1:33 to play. The Hopkins defense was smothering on the extra-point attempt, breaking up a pass attempt in the endzone.

Ian Mitchell threw for a career-high 323 yards and four touchdowns against Hopkins. That ranks him second on the list for passing yards in a game. He rushed for a fifth touchdown, tying Francis "Mother" Dunn '14 record for touchdowns in a game. Mitchell is currently tied for second in career total yards with 3,877.

Defense - The Devils had a tough time containing an explosive Hopkins offense in the first half. Some adjustments at the break proved to be beneficial as the Devils made a valient run at the Blue Jays.

The Devils outscored Hopkins 34-3 over the final 17 minutes of the game. Three Devils reached double-figures on Friday night, led by a game and career-high 19 from senior captain Ben Hargrave. A.J. Reisig tallied 14 tackles and Michael Dalton registered 13 on the night. Hargrave leads the Devils and the conference with 70 tackles this season.

Kevin Wood and Michael Maxwell each recorded eight stops and recovered fumbles, one forced by Pat McNeal.

The Devils rank second in the CC in total defense, and rank third rushing and pass defense. They top the CC in red-zone defense, stopping opponents 61 percent of the time this fall.

Special Teams- The Devils' dropped a kick-off in no-man's land against Hopkins that was recovered by Michael Maxwell on the Johns Hopkins' eight yard line. That recovery set-up the Devils third touchdown of the game.

Scouting Gettysburg - The Bullets own the top-rated passing offense in the conference through the first half of the season. The Bullets rank first in total offense and second in scoring offense as well. Junior QB Matt Flynn leads the CC in passing yards and total offense, averaging 252.7 and 282.1 yards per game, respectively in those categories. He is just 286 yards from the school record for passing yards.

Josh Jerrold leads the Bullets and the CC with 7.5 sacks, 9.5 tackles-for-loss and four forced fumbles.
