Setting the Stage - The Red Devils welcome unbeaten Moravian College to Biddle Field this weekend. The Greyhounds, in just their second year in the Centennial Conference, are off to a 4-0 start and sit atop the CC standings at 2-0. The Devils suffered a disappointing 20-13 setback at McDaniel to slip to 2-2 overall and 1-1 in conference play.

The teams played a thriller in Bethlehem last season with the Devils claiming a 24-23 victory as Gordon Craig hit a 32-yard field-goal in the final seconds.

Last Week - The Red Devils produced 423 yards of total offense while holding McDaniel to just 193 for the day. Unfortunately, field position and turnovers played a major role as the Devils suffered a 20-13 setback in Westminster. The Devils struggled from the start, fumbling the opening kick-off on the 20 yard line, leading to an early score by the Green Terror.

Wet conditions would lead to four fumbles and three turnovers on the day, including one in the red zone late in the first half. The Devils were driving in the final seconds but were stopped just shy of the goal line as time ran out..

Junior quarterback Ian Mitchell rushed for 131 yards and completed 14-of-24 passes for 148 yards on the day. Classmate Pat O'Connor was just shy of the century mark, making seven catches for 99 yards. Sophomore Gregory Lord covered 81 yards on 21 carries while Tim Wells added 55 yards.

Kevin Wood and Ben Hargrave each tallied a team-high 11 tackles. Steve Bokron was in on a pair of sacks while A.J. Reisig and Tredell Johns each forced a fumble.

Last Year - The Devils rallied to score 10 points in the final nine minutes, including a last second field-goal by Gordon Craig to knock-off the Greyhounds in Bethlehem, 24-23. Mitchell completed 21-of-29 passes for 230 yards. He completed five straight passes on the final drive to set up the game-winning field-goal.

Chris McInerney made 11 catches for 95 yards and tallied 203 all-purpose yards while Pat O'Connor scored twice, covering 117 yards on seven receptions.

Ryan Heinig anchored the defensive effort with seven solo tackles, a forced fumble and an interception that led to the game-winning drive.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 98-60-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

The Series - The Devils meet the Greyhounds for the 12th time, renewing the series last fall when Moravian joined the Centennial Conference. Dickinson leads the series 5-4-2 and is 3-0-1 in the last four meetings on Biddle Field.

Offense - Ian Mitchell raised his career numbers to 1,177 yards rushing and 2,151. He is the first Red Devil quarterback to rush for over 1,000 and pass for 2,000 in school history. He ranks third in the CC this season with 940 yards of total offense.

Pat O'Connor was just shy of the century mark last week, making seven catches for 99 yards. He went of the 1,000 yard mark on his first catch on Saturday, raising his career total to 1,094. He leads the conference in receptions (7.0/gm) and is second in receiving yards per game at 112.2, covering a CC-best 449 yards.

Gregory Lord scored his conference-best ninth TD of the year on Saturday. He ranks third in the CC in rushing, averaging 105.2 yards per game.

The Red Devils are second in the CC in rushing offense, and third in both total offense and pass efficiency this season.

Defense - The Red Devil defense ranks second in the Centennial in total defense and third in rushing defense this season. The Devils held McDaniel to just 65 yards passing and 193 yards of total offense on Saturday. Unfortunately, favorable field position proved to be just enough for the Green Terror to post a 20-13 win last weekend.

Sophomore Kevin Wood posted a career-high 11 tackles to lead the effort for Dickinson. Senior captain Ben Hargrave was in on 11 tackles as well. Hargrave ranks second in the CC, averaging 9.5 tackles per outing while Wood also ranks in the top 10 with eight stops per game.

Senior Tredell Johns is third in sacks and tackles-for-loss in the CC. Steve Bokron was in on a pair of sacks on Saturday, ranking fifth in the conference for sacks per game (0.75).

Adam Lick tallied nine tackles on Saturday and was in the backfield all afternoon. Michael Dalton added nine tackles as well while Johns and A.J. Reisig each forced a fumble last week.

Special Teams - O'Connor and Lord rank third and fourth in the conference for all-purpose yards at 154.2 and 135.2 yards per game, respectively.

Scouting Moravian - The Greyhounds are off to a 4-0 start for the second straight season and are 2-0 in the Centennial Conference.

Senior kicker Brian Reckenbeil set a pair of school records last Saturday. He booted four field-goals (22,28, 30 and 26 yds) and was 3-of-3 on extra-points, extending his consecutive streak to 51.

The Greyhounds lead the conference in rushing offense with two players in the top 10 for rushing this season. Tyler McCambridge ranks fourth, averaging 102.2 yards per game, followed by Tyler deRouen at 92.0 per game to hold the number six spot.

Defensively, Moravian tops the CC in scoring defense and turnover margin, allowing just 10.8 points per game this season. They have a (+12) take-away margin and a conference-best 13 sacks on the year.

Senior linebacker Kevin McGorry leads the Greyhound defense with 36 tackles on the season, followed by Andrew Morrissey with 32.
