**Setting the Stage** - The Red Devils came off a bye week to defeat Gettysburg 29-16. The Devils used an overall team effort to keep the Little Brown Bucket in Carlisle and give head coach Darwin Breaux his 100th career victory. Muhlenberg comes in ranking second in the nation with a 7-0 record and a 5-0 mark in the Centennial Conference. The Mules overcame a slow start to post a 17-6 win over Franklin & Marshall last week.

**Last Week** - The Red Devils received a solid effort on both sides of the ball and on special teams to turn back the Bullets last weekend. Sophomore Gordon Craig kicked three field-goals and senior Steve Bokron broke the game open with a 54 yard fumble return for a touchdown.

Sophomore Pat O'Connor caught nine passes for 104 yards and one touchdown while junior Tim Wells grounded out 85 yards rushing and scored on a seven yard run. Junior quarterback Ian Mitchell completed 14-of-23 passes for 160 yards while rushing for 66 as well.

Michael Dalton led the defense with 10 tackles, including six solo stops. He also added a 20 yard interception return. Kevin Wood tallied nine tackles and a sack while Matt Stone recorded eight stops and forced a fumble. Overall the Devils totaled four sacks, two fumble recoveries and a pair of interceptions.

Muhlenberg ran its regular season win streak to 17 games with a 17-6 win over Franklin & Marshall. John DeLuca ran for 177 yards and one touchdown as he went over the 1,000-yard mark for the second straight season. David Mazzola averaged 46.3 yards on four punts, all downed inside the 20 yard line. Michael Katz kicked a career-long 42 yard field-goal and is 32-of-32 on PATs.

**Last Year** - The Devils jumped out to an early lead on Muhlenberg, scoring the game's first 17 points. The Mules battled back and scored with just 3:27 remaining to post a 29-24 win in Allentown. Tim Smith rushed for 73 yards and two touchdowns while Chris McInerney caught nine passes for 83 yards.

Eric Dube tallied a game-high 14 tackles, including eight solo stops and a tackle-for-loss. Michael O'Donnell added six tackles, three-for-losses and had three pass breakups. Michael Dalton recovered a fumble, blocked a kick and broke up a pair of passes as well.

### The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 100-61-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

**The Series** - The Devils meet the Mules for the 63rd time with Muhlenberg holding a 37-24-1 lead in the series. The Devils snapped a seven-game slide with a 24-14 win in the last meeting at Biddle Field in 2006.

**Milestones**- Head Coach Darwin Breaux reached a career milestone on Saturday with his 100th career win. He is in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil program, posting a 100-61-1 overall record.

**Offense** - The Red Devils rank second in the CC in rushing offense, third in total offense and fourth in passing this season. The Red Devil offensive line, anchored by senior Eric Angerstein and junior center Andrew Ciukurescu, lead the conference in sacks against, allowing just four on the year.

That protection has also led to a school record for single season receiving as Pat O'Connor caught nine passes for 104 yards on Saturday to raise his school record to 930 yards. The junior ranks third on the school's all-time list with 1,575 yards and is currently second for single season receptions at 56.

Ian Mitchell ranks second all-time in total offense with 4,103 yards in his career. He has rushed for 1,337 and passed for more than 2,700 yards, almost exclusively in the past two seasons.

Tim Smith returned to the line-up for a limited number of carries. Tim Wells and Gregory Lord each averaged over five yards per carry on Saturday. Wells led the way with 85 yards and a touchdown.

**Defense** - The Devils have used a balanced attack on the defensive side of the ball as well. Michael Dalton led the charge on Saturday with a team-high 10 tackles, including six solo stops. He returned an interception 20 yards that led to a Gordon Craig field-goal in the third quarter.

Kevin Wood recorded nine tackles and a sack while Matt Stone tallied eight stops and forced a fumble. Cole Glennon recovered one fumble and Steve Bokron picked up another and went 54 yards for a touchdown. Overall the Devils recorded five tackles-for-loss, including four sacks.

**Special Teams**- Gordon Craig connected from 21, 35 and 27 yards on Saturday to earn CC Special Teams Player of the Week honors. Senior punter Matt Stark averaged 38 yards with a long boot of 52 yards on Saturday.

**Scouting Muhlenberg** - The Mules are ranked fourth in the nation by d3football.com and second by the American Football Coaches Association. They lead the conference standings with a 5-0 mark and are unbeaten at 7-0 this season. The Mules have won 17 straight regular season games and 13 consecutive CC contests.

The Mules top the CC in scoring and rushing offense, and rank first in scoring, rushing and total defense. They will bring their top-rated red-zone offense in to face the second-rated red-zone defense in the CC.

Senior John DeLuca leads all CC rushers, averaging 159 yards per game, scoring nine touchdowns. Classmate Eric Santagato rates at the top of the conference in pass efficiency and is second in passing yards per game at 192 per outing.

Phil Cresta ranks behind leader Pat O'Connor in receptions and receiving yards with 46 catches for 107 yards per game.

Matt Rathbun leads the Mules in tackles at 6.9 per game. Brandon Doyle tops the CC with 1.5 breakups per game and Jeremiah Lachaud has four sacks this season.
