**Setting the Stage** - Dickinson welcomes 17th-ranked Hobart College to Biddle Field for the 2009 home opener. The Red Devils won their seventh straight season opener, surviving a shootout in Grove City, 52-47.

The early match-up between the Devils and Statesmen has provided some thrilling contests in the series. The home team has proven victorious in six of the last seven meetings, with 2006 and 2007 being decided by a field-goal. Last year, Hobart scored in the final minutes to escape with a 28-21 win.

**Last Week** - Hobart was idle last week while the Red Devils traveled west to face Grove City College. Senior Ian Mitchell had a huge afternoon, throwing for 288 yards and two touchdowns. He ran for another 149 yards and two scores, including a 45 yard score in the fourth quarter. Classmate Patrick O'Connor turned in a great performance as well, making nine catches for 164 yards on the day. The Red Devils scored 35 points in the second half, including 28 in the fourth quarter alone, totaling over 500 yards of offense in the game.

Senior Michael Maxwell led the defensive effort with a game-high 13 tackles. Junior Pete Hamill tallied 10 tackles, including 1.5 sacks. Pat McNeal and Kevin Wood each recorded nine tackles while McNeal added two tackles-for-loss and a key sack late in the game.

**Last Year** - Hobart scored with just 54 seconds remaining in the game to post a 28-21 win in Geneva last fall. It was the third straight year that the home team came away with a victory, and the third consecutive game decided by a touchdown or less.

Gregory Lord reached the century mark for the second straight week, covering 106 yards on 19 carries, scoring a pair of touchdowns. Mitchell completed 14-of-23 passes for 176 yards while O'Connor caught six passes for 101 yards and a touchdown.

Kevin Wood led the defense with eight tackles, one-for-loss and a forced fumble. Tredell Johns added seven tackles and 1.5 sacks on the afternoon.

## The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 103-62-1 record in his 17th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in four of the past five years.

**The Series** - The Devils lead a very close series, 9-8-1, as the teams meet for the 19th time. Dickinson is 5-3 at home against the Statesmen, escaping with a 30-27 win here in 2007.

**Offense** - Senior quarterback Ian Mitchell was named the Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week for his performance in the opener at Grove City. His 437 yards of total offense was the second-highest in school history and the fourth-best in the history of the Centennial Conference. Mitchell has gone over 300 yards of total offense six times in his career.

The Devils had over 500 yards of total offense, scoring 35 points in the second half, including 28 in the fourth quarter. Mitchell completed 21-of-27 passes for 288 yards and two touchdowns. He ran for 149 yards and two scores. He ranks second in the conference in rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,801.

Senior Patrick O'Connor had a big afternoon as well, making nine catches for 164 yards. He holds the school record and became the first Dickinson receiver to go over 2,000 yards in his career. O'Connor ranks second in receptions with 138 for 2,133 yards.

**Defense** - The Devils knew they would have their hands full with Grove City quarterback Andrew DiDonato. The senior did all he could to keep the Wolverines in the hunt, but the Devils held in the end to secure a season opening road win.

Senior Michael Maxwell led all tacklers with 13 stops on the day. Pete Hamill played well in his first start, recording 10 tackles and 1.5 sacks. Junior Pat McNeal added nice tackles, including two-for-losses. He made a huge sack on 4th-and-7 in the fourth quarter to stall a critical Wolverine drive.

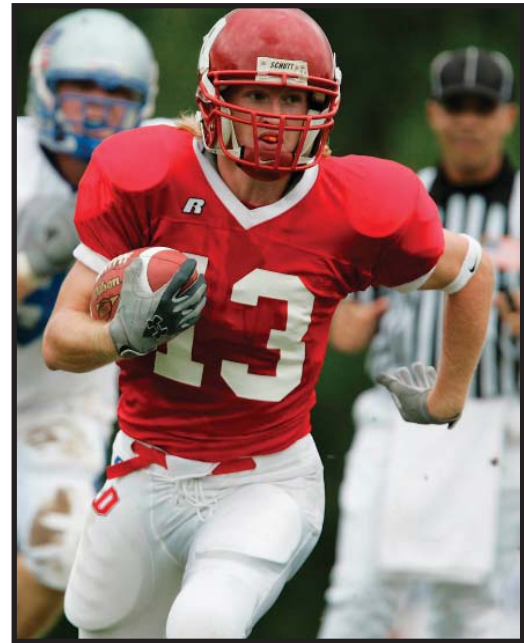
Kevin Wood tallied nine tackles while Andrew Fink had an interception and Joe Coffey recovered a fumble.

**Special Teams** - Gordon Craig split the uprights for a 39 yard field-goal and converted 6-of-6 extra-point attempts.

The teams combined for just three punts on the day as the Devils were forced to kick just once in the game, despite converting on just 6-of-13 third-downs. Dickinson was very effective on fourth-down, converting on 3-of-4 of those attempts.

**Scouting Hobart** - The Statesmen have been a staple in the NCAA playoffs in recent years, making five straight postseason appearances. Hobart has captured the past two Liberty League titles, advancing the second round of the NCAA Tournament last fall.

The Statesmen return 39 letter winners and 12 starters from 2008. They return seven starters on a defense that ranked fourth in the nation in pass efficiency defense.
